→ Asked his peers

Kings 12:9-11

Answer: the North abandons the house of David

Proverbs 15:1 - God's Eternal Covenant with David = 2 Samuel 7:15-16

Reason for Divided Kingdom?

1) Forsaken God - worshipped other gods (Ashtoreth, Chemosh, Milcom)

2) Israel had not walked in God's ways - not done what is right and kept God's rules and laws ... see 1 Kings 12:15

- 2) The LORD Keeps His Promise to David 1 Kings 12:20 God keeps all His promises to YOU!
