→They Didn't Deserve It

B) He Shouldn't Love Israel Either

Zechariah 7:10-12; Amos 4:1

→They Didn't Deserve It

→We don't Deserve It either:

Isaiah 53:6 We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

C) Mystery: God's Desire to Bring Salvation

Psalm 67:1-5

:Not only does God have a heart for all nations and all people, but God wants His people to have hearts that reflect His heart

II. God's Heart for His People's Heart

Jonah ... HE DOESN'T WANT HIS HEART TO CHANGE
