The story of Jonah is not about a great fish - it is about a great God who loves the nations!

 \rightarrow Amos 760-750

God promised judgment and vast destruction was soon to fall upon them but He also promised HOPE.

 \rightarrow Micah 735-701

He prophesied during the times of Isaiah and King Hezekiah. At times, it was a season of unmatched prosperity ... the people said "*disgrace* will not *overtake* us."

 \rightarrow Hosea 750-722

God gives one last prophet, with one unforgettable illustration of God's love.

 \rightarrow Nahum 663-612

God comforts Israel foretelling of judgment on Nineveh - Nineveh fell 612.

 \rightarrow Zephaniah 640-609

Zephaniah foretold of the coming Day of the LORD but God was a mighty one in their midst who will save.

 \rightarrow Habakkuk 605

"How can God use a wicked country like Babylon for His divine purposes?"

 \rightarrow Joel 597-586

Joel told of a locust plague and emphasized the Day of the LORD and a day when God would pour out Holy Spirit.

 \rightarrow Obadiah 586

Obadiah reminded the people that Edom's wicked actions of betraying their brothers would not be overlooked.

 \rightarrow Haggai 520

Haggai reminded the people that God was with them and that they should prioritize the rebuilding of the Temple.

 \rightarrow Zechariah 520

God was interested not just in their rebuilding project, but especially their spiritual formation. Zechariah beckoned the people to return to God.

→ Malachi 450-400

The people were still the Same ... But so was God ... He never changes!!! God is our hope. *Malachi 3:6* "For I the LORD do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed.

In sum, the message of the Minor Prophets is simple: the people remain the same and God calls them to return to Him. The solution of the Minor prophets is simple: God remains the same and no one who turns to Him with a sincere heart will be rejected and will never be put to shame. He is coming back to take His people Home!
